Alec's accomplishments in ballroom dance are even more notable because at a very young age, Alec was diagnosed with Asperger Syndrome. Those living with Asperger Syndrome often exhibit repetitive routines or rituals, peculiarities in speech and language, and difficulty interacting with their peers.

Alec and his grandmother, however, discovered the ability within Alec's disability! They found that Alec's innate talent for dancing was enhanced by his abilities in math and counting that are often a part of Asperger Syndrome. Alec learns routines through visualization and counting, as he watches the steps required for each dance. Once his coaches adjusted their teaching to fit his style of learning, Alec soon took the competitive dance circuit by storm, and he looks forward to entertaining everyone at the Gala!
